#### **Commercial**



- Deliveries: Boeing has directly delivered over 4,600 commercial aircraft to more than 130 European customers in the last six decades.
- Forecast: European airlines are forecast to acquire almost 9,000 new aircraft in the next 20 years.
- **Supply chain:** Boeing 737, 747, 767, 777 and 787 programmes boast breakthrough technologies and systems from hundreds of European suppliers.
- Launch customers: Several European airlines have partnered with Boeing to launch new aircraft models, including the Boeing 737, 747-8 and all-new 777X.
- Manufacturing: High-tech Boeing 737 and 767 components are manufactured in Sheffield, U.K.
- Passengers: Each year, Boeing aircraft carry 385 million passengers from Europe to destinations all over the world.

- Boeing solutions play an integral role in the military, peacekeeping and humanitarian assistance operations of NATO and many European nations.

- Boeing provides unparalleled aerospace services to more than 350 European customers.
- Boeing Flight Services: Each year, approximately 1,000 pilots from Europe, Africa and the Middle East are trained at the Gatwick campus.
- **Jeppesen** offers air navigational information through its European offices in Germany, Italy, U.K., Sweden and Poland.
- Boeing Distribution Services has operations in Germany, U.K., France, Poland, Czech Republic, Italy and Spain.
- Adient Aerospace is a Boeing-Adient joint venture offering a portfolio of aircraft seats out of Germany.
- Aviall, an aircraft parts distributor with offices in the Netherlands, supplies chemicals, tools and materials.
- Initium Aerospace is a new Boeing-Safran 50-50 joint venture to design, build and service APUs.
